**SOME TASKS FOR EACH
GRADE-LEVEL:**

It's interesting that on page 41, the text refers to school as "a bridge we all need to cross."

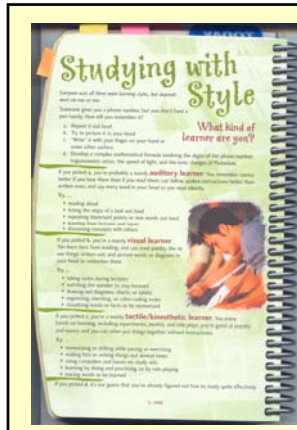
It's good for kids to see that school is a means to an end – a tool that can get them prepared for their future.

**Turn to page 150 and 151 (the section on studying and taking tests)*

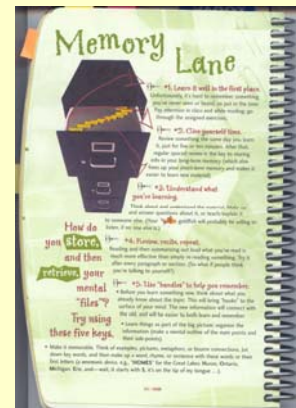
Here is a review of some tips for students to use as they study for final exams.
